



Council Regulation (EEC) 881/92 of 26 March 1992 on access to the market in the carriage of goods by road within the Community to or from the territory of a Member State or passing across the territory of one or more **Member States** (OJ L 95 of 09.04.1992)



# **REGULATION N° 881/92 (1)**

# Applies to:

- International road goods transport for "hire or reward" by Community hauliers:
  - between 2 Member States,
  - transiting a Member State while on a journey between:
    - a Member State and a third country,
    - 2 third countries



# REGULATION N° 881/92 (2) Haulier:

- Needs to access to the profession for international road transport (Directive 96/26/EC);
- Can then apply to his national authorities for Community license (which is not subject to quantitative restrictions);
- Needs to carry a certified copy of the Community license in the vehicle.



# **REGULATION N° 881/92 (3)**

- Community License is valid for 5 years;
- Member States have to inform the Commission each year of the number of valid:
  - \* Community licenses, and
  - \* Certified copies (corresponding to the number of vehicles)



## FIRST COUNCIL DIRECTIVE

- Specifies international transport NOT requiring a Community license (or any other authorization):
  - \* Own Account;
  - \* Small vehicles (less than 6t gross vehicle weight OR 3.5t carrying capacity);
  - \* Mail;
  - \* Broken-down or damaged vehicles;
  - \* Emergency relief





Council Regulation (EEC) 3118/93 of 25 October 1993 laying down the conditions under which non-resident carriers may operate national road haulage services within a Member State

(OJ L 279 of 12.11.1993)

as amended by Council Regulation (EC) N° 3315/94 and by Regulation (EC) N° 484/2002 of the European Parliament and the Council



# **REGULATION N° 3118/93 (1)**

Applies to

- National road goods transport by nonresident hauliers (cabotage), <u>but</u>
- only ,,on a temporary basis";
- Haulier must have a Community license;



# **REGULATION N° 3118/93 (2)**

Need to follow host Member State rules for:

- rates and conditions;
- weights and dimensions:
- requirements for special goods (dangerous goods, perishable foodstuffs, live animals
- driving and rest time;
- Value Added Tax



Council Regulation (EEC) 3916/90 of 21 December 1990 on measures to be taken in the event of a crisis in the market in the carriage of goods by road

(OJ L 375 of 31.12.1990)



# **REGULATION N° 3916/90**

- Crisis mechanism;
- Operates only if there is a persistent crisis;
- Crisis can only be signaled by Member States, not Commission;
- No crisis signaled in 16 years;
- It applies to:
  - \* International intra-Community transport;
  - \* Cabotage.
