Based on Article 71 of the Treaty

liberalization of market access measure



Aims: to allow for a flexible adaptation of fleet capacity
by transport undertakings
by permitting the use of hired vehicles



Scope: Requires that a Member State allows the use within its territory of hired vehicles (for the purpose of international goods transport) by its own national undertakings and by an undertaking established on the territory of another Member State



Conditions:

- the vehicle must be hired by the undertaking in the Member State of its establishment
- contract relates only to the vehicle (not accompanied by a service contract)
- vehicle must be at sole disposal of the undertaking during hire period and is driven by its own personnel
- proof of compliance kept on board (vehicle hire contract, driver's employment contract)



Additional conditions:

- Member States may provide (for undertakings established on their territory) that own-account transport operations carried out with vehicles with a laden weight of more than 6 tonnes
- are not allowed with hired vehicles

Member States can not require a minimum hiring period
