



Council Regulation (EEC) 4060/89 on the elimination of controls performed at the frontiers of Member States in the field of road and inland waterway transport

(OJ L 390 of 30.12.1989)





REGULATION Nº 4060/89

- Elimination of controls at frontiers between Member States;
- Controls, e.g. on weights and dimensions, to be carried out, on a sample basis, within the territory;
- Applies to road and inland waterways;
- Applies to Community vehicles and vessels.

REGULATION Nº 3912/92

- Extends Regulation N°4060/89 on abolition of controls at the Community's internal frontiers to vehicles and vessels registered in third countries.
- Any necessary controls on vehicles and vessels registered in third countries are to be performed at the Community's external frontier.
