Annual economic accounts 1. GENERAL BACKGROUND

National accounts (ESA95 and the associated data transmission programme) provide the basis for macro-economic analysis, policy assessment and surveillance. Furthermore, national accounts data are used for important administrative purposes in the EU (own resources, EDP, structural funds)

Annual economic accounts 3. MOST PROBLEMATIC ISSUES

- Implementation of FISIM
- Implementation of the principles for volume measurement
- Transmission of long time series of the main national accounts aggregates (as defined in the ESA95 transmission programme)
- Transmission of data on the day they become available nationally

- Draft Regulation on the revision of the ESA95 transmission programme
- Implementation of the new NACE in 2011
