- 1. Community policies e.g.:
 - preparation for multilateral and bilateral trade negotiations,
 - evaluate the progress of the internal Market
- 2. National policies e.g.:
 - Compilation of balance of Payments Statistics & National Accounts
- 3. Decision making on Business-level e.g.:
 - Carrying out market research and define commercial strategies

Intrastat

- Direct collection of information from companies
- A close link with the VAT system
- A threshold system

Extrastat

- Dependent fromCustoms rules
 - ≈ Total coverage

- Other data made available by Customs (optional Extra)

3. MOST PROBLEMATIC ISSUES

3.1 Implementing a new statistical system (Intrastat)

- The change from administrative data sources to direct data collection
- Identification and monitoring of parties responsible for providing the information (trade register)
- Exhaustiveness and quality control through fiscal information (VAT system)
- Adjustments for trade below the threshold and late response
- Change of organisational and administrative responsibilities for data collection, processing and dissemination





3.2 Adaptation of current external trade statistics to the Extrastat system

 Expanded list of data elements (e.g. Taric, Preferences, Statistical procedures)

 Preparation of data files according to Community transmission agreements (Doc Meth 400)





4. FUTURE ACQUIS

Intrastat

- Reflection on further simplification
- Studies carried out in 2006
- Analysing the results in 2007
- Options:
 - Simplification of the CN
 - Increase threshold
 - One flow system

Extrastat

- New legislation (2009)
 - Collection of revised customs data
 - Take into consideration E—Customs, Centralised Customs Clearance
 - Increase quality of the information (revisions)
 - Compile complementary related statistics
