#### Why?

Provide the Commission with statistics needed for an effective energy policy

Provide high quality statistical services and products to other users

Implement actions improving national statistical systems (EU Member States and Accession Countries)





## 1. GENERAL BACKGROUND

#### What?

#### **Energy Quantities:**

Solid fuels, natural gas, oil, electricity, renewable energy

#### **Energy prices:**

Electricity and natural gas

(for industry and for households)

#### **Energy Market parameters:**

Competition indicators, price systems





## 1. GENERAL BACKGROUND

Which frequencies?

**Energy Quantities:** 

Annual, monthly (M-3), monthly (M-1)

Energy prices:

Every 6 months





# 2. THE ACQUIS

#### At the moment almost nothing:

- •Council Directive 90/377/EEC: transparency of gas and electricity prices:
  - -only industrial consumers
  - -Presently under review
- •EP & Council Directive 2004/8/EC: cogeneration





## 3. MOST PROBLEMATIC ISSUES

#### In general:

- Difficulties in Member States due to energy market liberalization and confidentiality problems
- Lack (as for today) of a legal basis for data collection on energy quantities





# 4. FUTURE ACQUIS

#### **Planned:**

- EP & Council Regulation: complete data collection of energy quantities: foreseen 2007
- EP & Council Regulation: foreseen 2008
  - -electricity and gas prices (industrial consumers and households)
  - -Price systems of electricity and gas

- 1. Annual statistics:
  - Data on CHP missing
- 2. Monthly statistics:
  - M-3 statistics on coal missing for 2005
  - Price systems to be developed







## 5. SPECIFIC QUESTIONS

#### Turkey

- 1. Annual statistics:
  - Data to be sent not only to the IEA but also us (oil, gas, electricity)!
  - No breakdown of heat consumption
  - Data consistency between questionnaires
- 2. Monthly statistics:
  - No M-3 statistics (oil, gas, electricity, coal)
- 3. Prices and price systems: to be developed
