Sustainable development 2. THE ACQUIS

- Communication of Commissioner Almunia on SDI (2005)
- Issue-oriented, multi-level framework derived from SD Strategy and related policies
- European Council (June 2006) reporting requirement & development of indicators
- Data collected from different statistical domains and external sources: 10 main themes

Sustainable development 3. MOST PROBLEMATIC ISSUES

- List of indicators could change with reviewed strategy
- Not all indicators based on official statistics, quality problems
- Request for composite indicators





Sustainable development 4. FUTURE ACQUIS
