HISTORICAL BACKGROUND



Turkey became a member of the EEA in 2003.

The Directorate General for EIA and Planning of Ministry of Environment and Forestry appointed as the National Focal Point to the EEA.





NATIONAL EIONET STRUCTURE


In line with the decision of the management board of the EEA, number of National Reference Centers (NRC) was reduced to 24 in 2005.

National Focal Point (NFP) team has been strengthened to include a number of Topic Coordinators, who's responsibilities are to support the NRCs and Primary Contact Points (PCP) in fulfilling their roles.





DECENTRALISED TURKISH EIONET STRUCTURE








OBJECTIVES OF THE NATIONAL EIONET STRUCTURE

- Compliance with the new EIONET structure as decided by the EEA Management Board
- Fulfilling of the reporting requirements of the EEA
- Strengthening Turkey's position in the EEA
- Capacity building within the involved institutions
- Strengthening cooperation at institutional and expert level
- Dissemination of the experience and knowledge gained from the EEA to the relevant national institutions and experts











ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE NFP

- Responsible for promoting knowledge about the EEA at national level
- Responsible for disseminating knowledge about EEA products in Turkey (subscribe to the EEA notification service on new publications)
- Act as advisor to the Turkish EEA Management Board Member
- Responsible for the functioning of the national EIONET
- Responsible for organising information meetings with the members of the national EIONET

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE NRCs AND PCPs

- National experts nominated by MoEF on topic related issues
- Data and knowledge provider within the topic area
- Responsible for fulfilling the EEA reporting requirements within their topic area
- Responsible for ensuring capacity building of national EIONET through networking with experts of EU Institutions
- Provide NFP with topic specific input for the meetings of the NFP/EIONET group and the Management Board upon request
- Contact point of the EEA for the specific topic area
- In related areas, PCP is responsible for coordinating the contributions and participation of the NRCs in the EIONET.





REPORTING

In 2006, the number of reporting obligations of Turkey is 7. The efforts are ongoing in order to upload reports before the deadline.

The reporting obligations are uploaded by PCP under the coordination of MoEF. Deliveries of data and information are made to the EEA Central Data Repository (CDR).

Nationally Designated Areas Report (CDDA) was uploaded to EIONET as the first reporting from Turkey in 2005. Besides we were uploaded air and marine reports.


