- In Turkey's accession negotiations 14 chapters were opened and one chapter was provisionally closed.
- 14 chapters are blocked due to the political decisions of the EU Council and Southern Cyprus.
- Although the screening process of 33 chapters had been completed in 2006, screening reports of 9 chapters have not yet been approved by the Council. Therefore, opening benchmarks for these chapters have not been communicated to Turkey officially.
