

- Training about the advocacy, lobbying and misuse of herbicides to 200 members of CSOs working in the agricultural and rural development area.
- Arranging working visit to the Czech Republic for the information and experience sharing
- Preparation of the Project website, informative booklets, and brochures.
- Carrying out campaign works for the establishment of Agricultural and Rural Development Commissions in 3 City Councils operating in Mersin
- Arranging workshops towards the healthy use of herbicides within the scope of farmers' training program



- 1 report will be prepared which shows the current situation of CSOs operating in Mersin and its region in the agricultural and rural development area by means of carrying out local and national resource search and SWOT analysis.
- Training on advocacy, lobby activities and weed control will be provided to 200 members of the relevant CSOs in 3 different locations.
- More active and democratic participation of civil society in policy and decisionmaking processes in agricultural and rural development area will be strenghtened through the development of communication and advocacy skills of 5 local CSOs.
- 30 hours training about advocacy, lobbying, and weed control will be provided to 20 persons who work in the decision-making mechanisms of the relevant CSOs.
- A commission consisting of local CSOs operating in the agricultural and rural development area will be opened in 3 city councils in Mersin.



- At least 10 CSOs will participate in the project's networking meeting.
- Education materials will be distributed to the relevant stakeholders and published online.
- A roadmap / action plan will be prepared for the national network.
- The cooperation between the CSOs in 3 pilot areas and within the CSO network and their counterparts in the EU member states will increase.
- The influence of civil society in the local government structures in the pilot areas of the Project will increase.
