Acquis under management of DG Enterprise and Industry

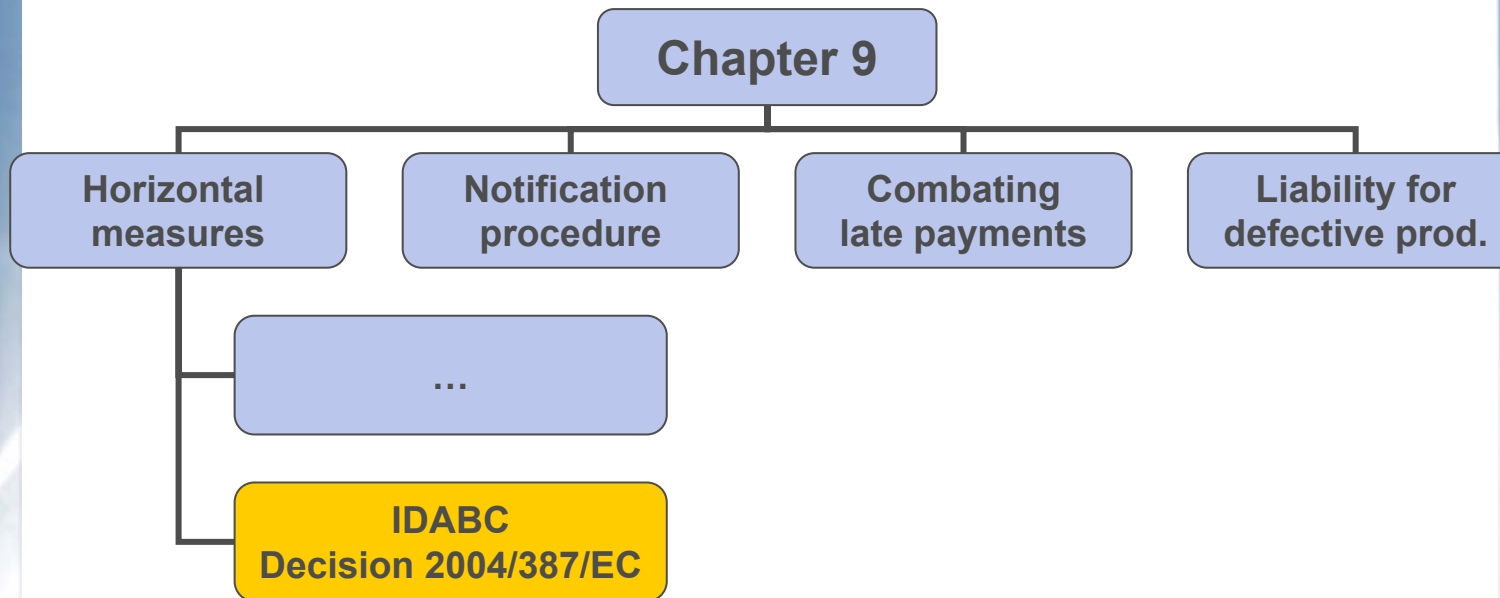
DG Enterprise and Industry

Objective of Decision 2004/387/EC

Establishment of the **IDABC**
Programme for the period 2005 – 2009.
For **I**nteroperable **D**elivery of pan-European
eGovernment services to Public **A**dministrations,
Community institutions and other entities and to
European **B**usinesses and **C**itizens.

IDABC Programme

Objective of IDABC Programme

Identifying, supporting and promoting the development and establishment of **eGovernment services**

Global budget

148.7 million EUR

Actions in the Work programme are Commission-driven and implemented via public procurement

IDABC Activities

Projects of common interest

- support projects proposed by Commission services (establishment of networks or services) in different policy areas by funding, infrastructure and advise

- examples: **EIONET, Safe Sea Network, Ploteus...**

Horizontal measures

- measures to address basic and common requirements to many European eGovernment projects (network services e.g. **TESTA**, security services e.g. **PKI, BGCA**)

- business applications and studies (e.g. **CIRCA, IPM**)

- support: management, funding

TESTA Network

What is TESTA

- TESTA is the European Community's own private, IP-based network
- telecommunications interconnection platform for **secure information exchange** between European public administrations

Importance of TESTA

- TESTA is used as the back-bone network in many projects (specialised applications)
- connecting to TESTA is a prerequisite for connection to EURODAC, Safe Sea Network, Tachonet, Prociv-Net, FIU Net...

Co-ordination

Management

IDABC management committee:

- All Member States represented
- Advise on Work Programme, allocation of funding, strategy

Expert meetings:

- National experts and EC represent.
- Discuss matters specific to each action

Candidate countries

Active observer status in the committee and expert meetings

Participation in IDABC

Participation

Opened for Croatia and Turkey (Article 14 of the Decision)

Requirements

Adoption and signature of **Memorandum of Understanding** between a country and the EC specifying the terms and conditions of participation.

Progress

Both countries expressed their interest in participating in the IDABC programme and the process is ongoing.
