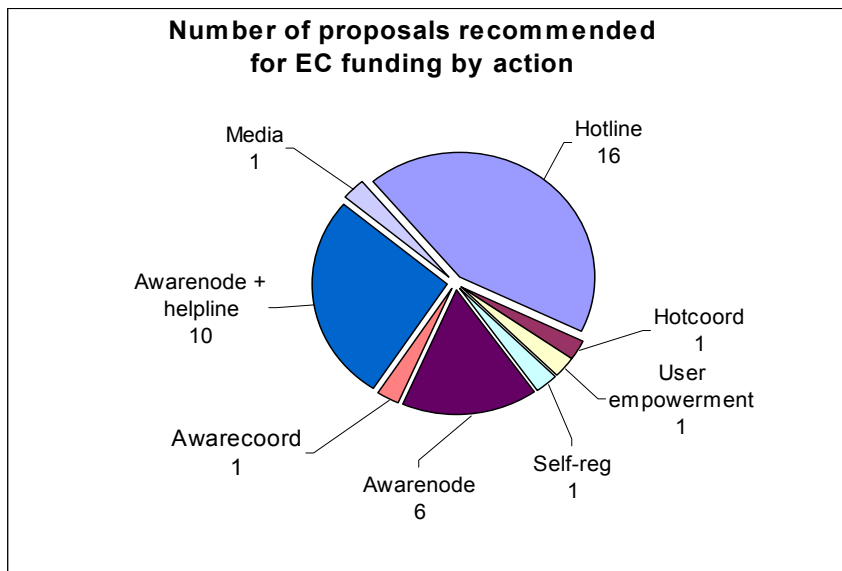




Status of implementation of the programme

37 proposals recommended for EC funding

29 September 2006.**

**Legal entities from Candidate
countries can submit proposals, but
selected projects can receive EC
funding only if MoU in force**
