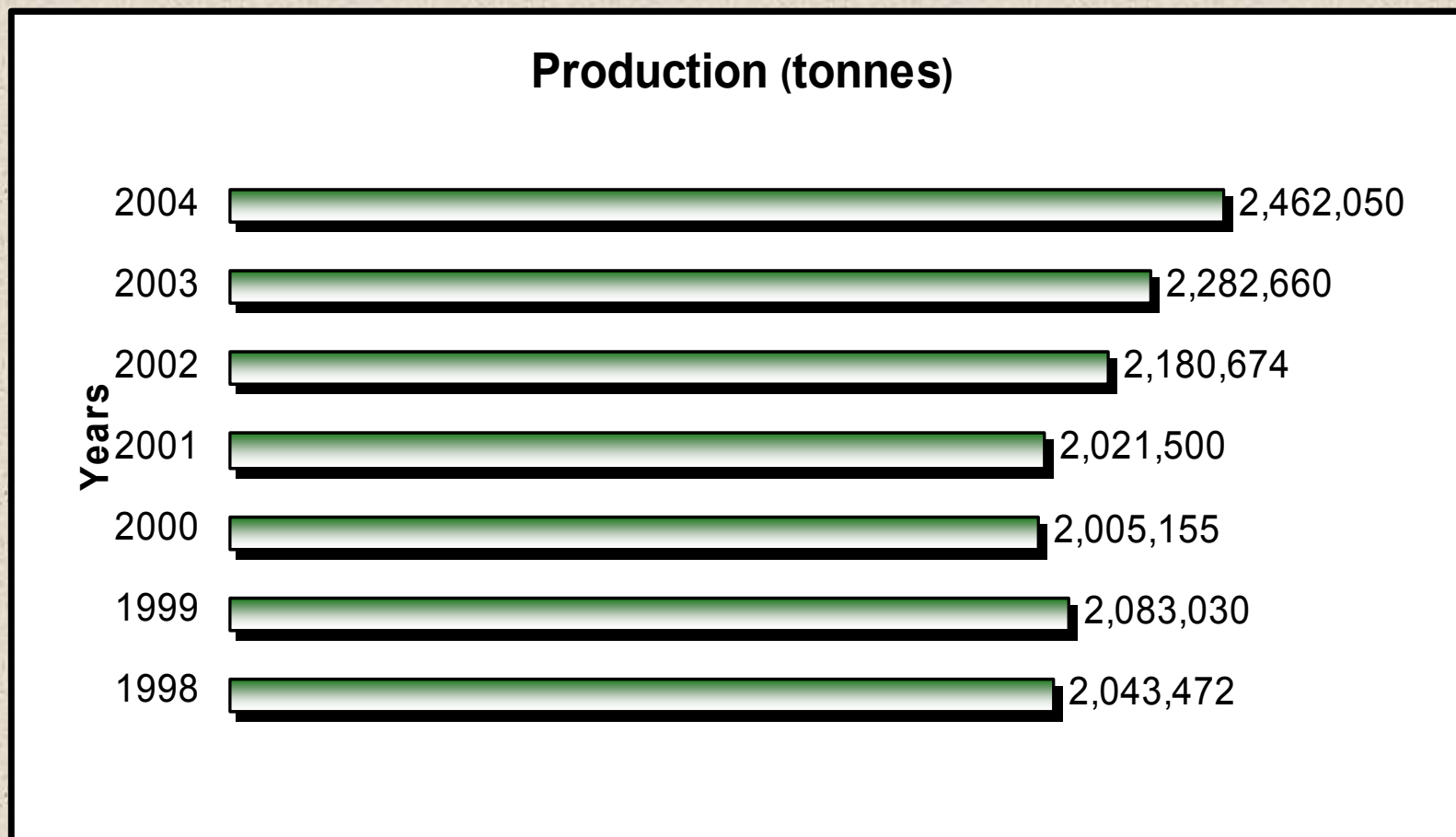
# I. AREA AND PRODUCTION

## II. SUPPORT



- no aid system for dried fodder. Green fodder is supported.
- fodder crops cultivation is supported by the Animal Husbandry Support Decree No: 2005/ 8503
  - perennial fodder crops : 40% of production costs and cost of machines and equipments purchased
  - annual fodder crops cultivation, 30% of production costs is direct paid to farmers directly.



- no specific dried fodder producer organisation,





## III. FOREIGN TRADE



- no import/export licenses
- these products are subject to the SPS controls by MARA.
- no export refund.
- Turkey-Bosnia and Herzegovina Free Trade Agreement 0 % duty on unlimited basis

TS 4728 Lucerne meal artificially heat-dried

TS 8603 Fodder drying rules

Not mandatory



# V. COMPARISON





- an aid for green fodder producers not for processing plant,
- no contract between producer and processing plant,
- no producers' organisations similar to the ones in CMO
- no central registration system for processors
- no control of dried fodder processed in terms of protein and moisture content
