- Sweet Corn, fresh or chilled

- Maize (corn) seed other than hybrid
- Maize other than seed
- Grain sorghum, other than hybrids for sowing

### Council Regulation 1784/2003 replaced Regulation 1766/92 (repealed).

- <u>Rye</u> intervention has been abolished from 2004/05 onwards
- Intervention price remained at previous level 101,31
  €/t (Article 4)
- <u>The Monthly increments</u>, November to June, have been cut by half - 0,46 €/t (Annex II)



#### Intervention (continues)

- Intervention is allowed for common wheat, durum wheat, maize, barley and sorghum.
- Intervention centres are determined according to Commission Regulation 2273/93
- <u>Buying in periods</u>: South of EU:1 Aug-30 April Sweden:1Dec-30 June) and all other MS: 1 Nov to 31 May (Art.5)



#### Intervention (continues)

- Minimum quantity and quality requirements for cereals to be eligible NB: New provisions on micotoxins
- Commission reg 824/2000 determines the procedure for analysis of cereals by intervention centres.



Imports/exports of products listed in article 1 of Reg 1784/2003 are subject to import/export certificates

- Commission regulation 1342/2003 on import and export certificates in the cereals sector has repealed Regulation 1162/95.
- All certificates are given subject to the lodging of a security
- Certificates are issued by MS to any applicant established in the EU and are valid throughout the EU.



•Import duties for cereals are in principle equal to the intervention price increased by 55 %, minus the respective CIF import price (Rotterdam price), Article 10 of Reg 1784/2003).

#### **Exceptions**

- Tariff Quotas for barley (feed and malting) and for soft wheat (medium and low quality)
  - Barley: 300.000 t + 50.000 t malting barley
  - Wheat: 2.981.600 of which 572 000 US and
