# Potato Starch



## Background:

- ❖ Eligible for production and export refunds and subject to import duty
- ❖ Potato starch in direct competition with cereal starch
- ❖ Potato producers not subject to set-aside system

# Potato Starch



## **Main provisions:**

- ❖ Limitation of production
- ❖ Payment to potato producer
- ❖ Premium paid to starch manufacturer
- ❖ Cultivation contract

# Potato Starch



## Internal support (1):

*Minimum price* paid by starch manufacturer to potato producer:

178.31 EUR

For the quantity of potatoes, delivered to the factory, which is needed for making one tonne of starch

Reg. (EC) No 1868/94 Art 4a

# Potato Starch



## Internal support (2):

*Aid* paid to potato producer:

66.32 EUR

For the quantity of potatoes, which is needed for making one tonne of starch

Reg. (EC) No 1782/2003 Art 93

# Potato Starch



## **Internal support (3):**

*Premium* paid to the starch manufacturer:

22.25 EUR

Per tonne of starch produced, up to the quota limit, provided that they have paid the minimum price to producers

Reg. (EC) No 1868/94 Art 5

# Potato Starch



## **Member States communicate by 30 June each year:**

- ❖ Quantities of starch potatoes
- ❖ Quantities of starch produced within the quota limit
- ❖ Quantities of starch produced above the quota limit and exported without refund
- ❖ Sub-quotas this year and following year
- ❖ If applicable, penalties applied
