# I. DEFINITION OF PET ANIMALS AND BASIC PRINCIPLES REGARDING PET ANIMALS





#### **Definition of Pet Animals**

- Those accompanied by their owner and looked after at home or office.
- >All responsibilities of animals belong to their owners.





## Basic principles regarding pet animals as set in Law no. 5199 on Animal Protection

- Animals have the freedom to live under conditions peculiar to their species.
- >Animals should be avoided of maltreatment.
- ➤ Conditions peculiar to the species should be respected during their care, feeding, sheltering and transport
- Animal shelters and hospitals should be established in compliance with animal welfare rules
- Animal owners are responsible for taking the necessary measures to avoid environmental pollution and prevent detriments and inconveniences.





➤ Introduction of the dangerous animals like Pitbull Terrier and Japanese Tosa is banned

# II. MOVEMENTS OF PET ANIMALS WITHIN TURKEY





#### Pet animals should be

- ➤ registered in accordance with Law No:5199 Animal Protection Law
- ➤ accompanied by veterinary health report in accordance with the Law no. 3285 Animal Health Control

### III. INTRODUCTION OF PET ANIMALS INTO TURKEY





#### **Three forms**

- Free if accompanied by the passenger (Customs Law)
  - √1 cat or 1 dog or 1 bird or 10 aquarium fish
- ►Importation: if number of animals is more than above figures, considered as commercial movement
  - ✓Import procedures apply and Control Document (SPS) issued by General Directorate of Protection and Control (GDPC) is required
- ➤ Temporary import: in case of special circumstances such as circus, horse races etc. without having a permanent Control Document provided that taxes for stay period is paid





## IV. HEALTH CONDITIONS FOR PET ANIMALS INTRODUCED INTO TURKEY





## Documents and conditions defined in Implementing Regulation on Animal Health Control

- >Accompanying Animals should have
  - -Veterinary Health Certificate
  - -Certificate of Origin
  - -Vaccination Document
  - -Identification Card





#### **Conditions**

- The animals must be clinically examined and found to be fit and healthy and showing no signs of contagious or infectious disease.
- ➤In case of dogs, they must have been vaccinated against
  - √ Canine Parvovirus
  - ✓ Leptospirosis
  - √ Hepatitis
  - √ Canine Distemper
  - ✓ Rabies at least 1 month ago





- ➤In case of <u>cats</u>,
  - ✓ they must have been vaccinated against rabies at least 1 months ago
  - √ they must be older than 4 months of age.
  - ✓ immunization period of Rabies must not be over.
