# I. BUDGETARY RESOURCES



- National Budget
  - ✓ Current Expenditures
  - ✓ Transfer Expenditures
  - ✓ Investment Expenditures
- Revolving funds
- Budget of Special Provincial Administrations



### Current Expenditures

- Used for personnel payments, and payments for stationery, water, electricity, fuel and communications, etc.

### Transfer Expenditures

- Used for compensation payments for culling of animals in line with the Law of Animal Health Control and payments for natural disasters

### Investment Expenditures

- Used for compensation payments for culling of animals as well as for all type of expenditures related to combat with animal diseases and pests (e.g. vaccines) within a project basis programme, cofinancing of EU financed projects



## Resources Allocated

- Central Organization
- Local Units (Provincial and District Directorates)
- Directorates of Veterinary Control and Research Institutes
- Revolving Funds





## Revolving Funds

### Incomes

- Transfers from National Budget
- Veterinary Services
  - ✓ Vaccination
  - ✓ Disinfection (for the transport of animals)
  - ✓ Laboratory Diagnostic Services

## Expenditure and Payment Procedure

- Budget appropriations according to the programme
  - prepared by MARA and
  - approved by Ministry of Finance.
  
- Budget components used based on submission of the documentation of expenditures through local accounting offices of the Ministry of Finance

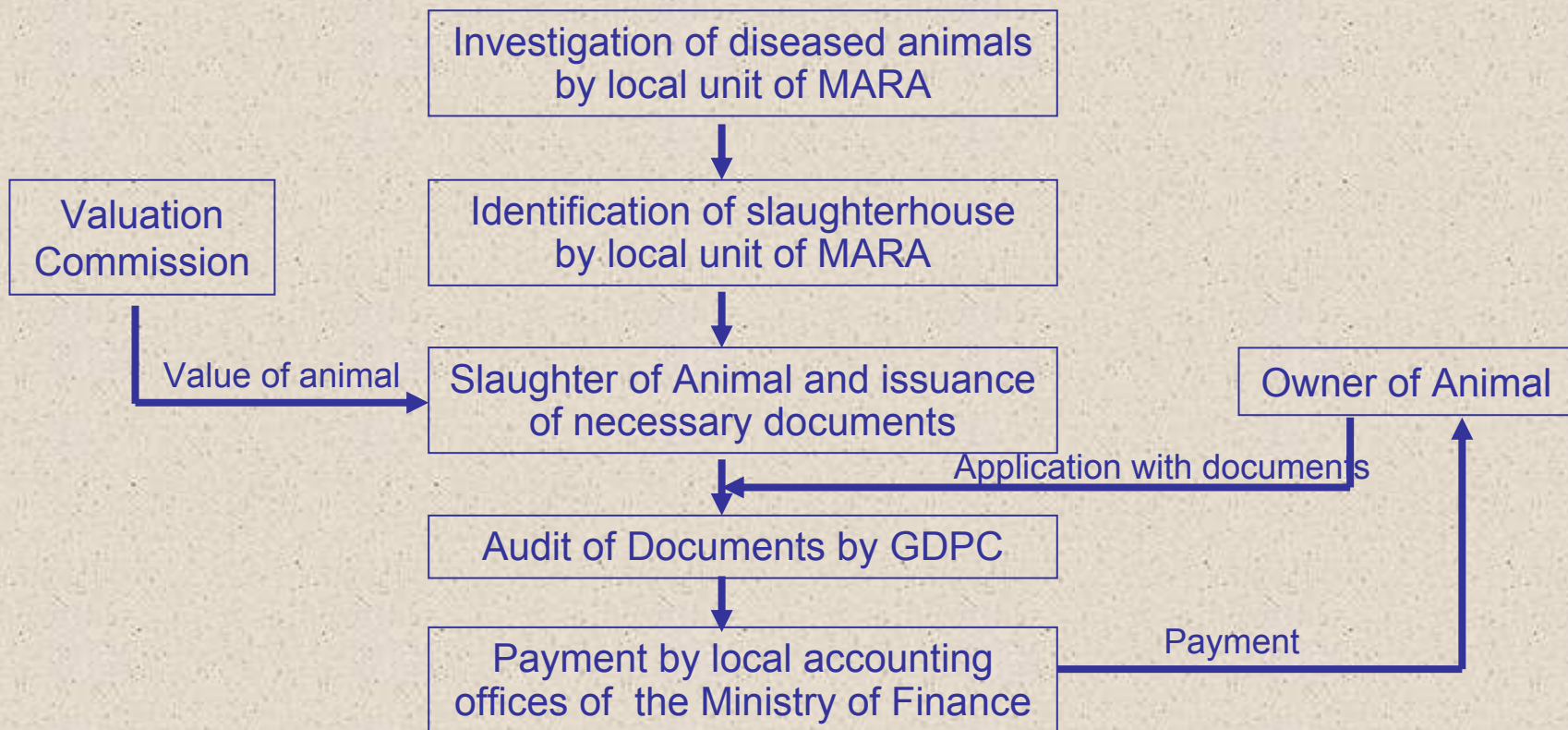


## Compensation

- In case of disease outbreaks, the owners of animals are compensated from the National Budget
- Compensated diseases in case of outbreaks are rinderpest, African horse sickness, glanders, bovine brucellosis, bovine tuberculosis, and foot and mouth disease (Article 41 of the Law of Animal Health Control)
  - Exception is compensation paid for culled animals in case of recent Avian Influenza (AI) outbreaks.
- Compensation is paid for foot and mouth disease only in the Thrace Region.
