Compulsory information on the labelling of foodstuffs

- The name of the foodstuff
- List of ingredients
- Net quantity
- Name, registered mark, address, place of production of manufacturer and also packager
- Expiry date
- Lot number and/or serial number
- Date and number of production allowance, registration number or date and number of import control certificate
- Country of origin
- Instructions for use and storage if necessary
- The amount of alcohol for beverages containing more than 1.2% by volume of alcohol
