III. CATEGORY I MATERIALS

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
> Animals having Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathy

- ✓ In case of Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy
 Killed, incinerated and buried according to Article 124 of Implementing Regulation on Animal Health Control
- ✓ In case of Scrapie
 Destroyed according to Article 123 of Implementing
 Regulation on Animal Health Control





Pet, Zoo, Circus and Experimental Animals







Specified Risk Materials (SRM)

There is no provision on determination and treatment

Products derived from animals to which substances prohibited or containing environmental contaminants and residues of other substances

Destroyed according to Article 18 of Food Law <u>and</u> 14/b of Implementing Regulation on Market Surveillance, Control and Inspection of Food





Catering Waste from Means of Transport Operating Internationally

WHO International Health Regulation adopted in 1973

- √ Wastes of international airplanes
 - Collected, transported and disposed according to Implementing Regulation on Control of Solid Wastes
- √ Wastes of international ships
 - Collected at waste "Acceptance Facilities", transfered to processing pants or sanitary landfill areas of municipalies and disposed according to Implementing Regulation on Waste Acceptance from Marine Vessels and Control of Waste





IV. CATEGORY II MATERIALS

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
> Manure and Digestive Tracts Content

- √ from small farms, used for agricultural purposes
- ✓ from large cattle farms, used after maturation.
- ✓ from sick animals, disinfected or burned.





> Animal Materials Collected from Waste Water








> Animal Products with High Amount of Drug Residues

✓ Destroyed according to Article 18 of Food Law <u>and</u> 14/b of Implementing Regulation on Market Surveillance, Control and Inspection of Food











>Animals Died or Killed to Eradicate an Epizootic Disease

- >Buried, incinerated or disposed of with chemicals
 - ✓ Burial in locations far from surface and groundwater resources, roads and residential areas
- Implementing Regulation on Certification and Inspection of Establishments Producing Fresh Meat and Meat Products
 - √ Class I slaughterhouses –incineration unit
 - ✓ Class II slaughterhouses –incineration unit or burial area





V. CATEGORY III MATERIALS

24-28 April 2006





- > Animal by Products Used for the Production of Feedstuff
 - ✓ Pieces not bigger than 5 cm
 - √ 135 °C,
 - √ 3 bars
 - √ 20 minutes
- Expired Products of Animal Origin and Raw Milk Originating from Animals that do not Show Clinical Signs of any Communicable Disease
 - ✓ Destroyed according to Article 18 of Food Law <u>and</u> 14/b of Implementing Regulation on Market Surveillance, Control and Inspection of Food





- Catering Waste
 - ✓ Collected, transferred and disposed
- Fishes and other sea animals caught in open-sea for producing fish flour and Fresh fish by-products in factories producing fish
 - ✓ Processed in rendering facilities
- Broken eggs, hatchery by-products and eggshells obtained from animals having no contagious disease
 - ✓ Processed in rendering facilities others not treated are disposed
