

Official approval of centres

Structure of premises

- * separate facilities
- * easily to clean and disinfect
- * isolation accommodation
- * independent storage allowed (for bovine semen)

Supervision of premises

- * permanent by a centre veterinarian
- * at least twice a year by an official veterinarian
- * entry prohibited to unauthorized persons
- * technically competent staff (hygiene procedures)



Health status of bulls

Herd of origin: officially free of TB, BRU, EBL

Isolation accommodation: pre-quarantine/quarantine testing (at least 28 days, TB, BRU, EBL, IBR, BVD, campylobacter fetus, trichomonas foetus)

Semen collection centre: routine testing

(annually, TB, BRU, EBL, IBR, BVD, campylobacter fetus, trichomonas foetus)



Health status of boars

• Herd of origin: officially free of brucellosis, no animal vaccinated against FMD in the preceding 12 months, no clinical signs of AD in the preceding 12 months.

• Isolation accommodation: pre-quarantine/quarantine testing (30 days, BRU, AD, CSF)

• Semen collection centre : routine testing (annually, BRU, AD, CSF)





Health status of sheep and goat

- Only sheep and goats from centres or holdings which:
- (a) are in good health on the day the semen is collected;
- (b) meet the requirements laid down in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of Directive 91/68/EEC on intra-Community trade (residency, no clinical signs of paraTB, ...etc)
- (c) Testing during the 30 days before the collection (B. melitensis, B. ovis, Border disease virus)

Health status of stallions

- Herd of origin: no clinical signs of EVA (for 30 days prior to collection), CEM (for 60 days prior to collection).
- Specific testing programs according to the residence status: EIA (Coggins), EVA, CEM.



Semen





- Testing prior to dispatch in case of **bulls**:
 - seropositive BVD routine tests
 - vaccinated against FMD 12 months prior to collection
- In case of positive routine tests: withdrawal from IC trade (since the last negative test)
- Traceability (marking of straws, records)
 - Transport: marked and sealed containers



LIST OF COLLECTION CENTRES IN THE MEMBER STATES

• **Legal Basis**: Art 13 (d) of Dir 92/65 – Art 5 (2) of Dir 88/407 and Dir 90/429

All approved collection centres shall be registered by the competent authority of the Member State concerned, each centres being given a veterinary registration number. A list of collection centres and their veterinary registration numbers shall be sent by each Member State to the other Member States and to the Commission, which shall also be notified of any amendment made to that list.

- Centre fulfils the requirements of Dir.
 90/429/EEC
- Centre officially approved for exports to the Community by the veterinary services of the TC concerned.
- Adoption by the Commission of a Decision adding the centre on the list.

OFFICIAL APPROVAL OF TEAMS

- STRUCTURE (permanent or mobile)
- * separate facilities (embryos/animals)
- * easily to clean and disinfect
- OPERATION
- * collection or production and processing in accordance with IETS recommendations
- * recording of activities of the team (donors, place of collection, destination of embryos)
- SUPERVISION
- * team veterinarian (permanent)
- * official veterinarian (at least twice a year)



HEALTH STATUS OF DONOR COWS

Herd of Origin

Spent at least the previous 6 months within the Community or in the third country of collection

- present in the herd of origin for at least 30 days prior to collection
- free of TB, BRU, EBL
- during the previous year, not be present in a herd which have shown any clinical sign of IBR.



HEALTH STATUS OF OTHER DONOR ANIMALS

- **Porcine animals**: meet the requirements of Dir. 64/432/EEC on intra-Community trade in live animals for breeding and production
- Ovine/Caprine animals: meet the requirements of Dir. 91/68/EEC on intra-Community trade in live animals for breeding and production
- Equidae: meet the requirements of Dir. 90/426/EEC and kept in holdings free from clinical signs of Contagious Equine Metritis for 60 days



LIST OF COLLECTION CENTRES IN THE MEMBER STATES

- Legal Basis: All approved teams shall be registered by the competent authority of the Member State concerned, each centres being given a veterinary registration number. A list of teams and their veterinary registration numbers shall be sent by each Member State to the other Member States and to the Commission, which shall also be notified of any amendment made to that list.
