

# Animal by-products Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002

(OJ L273, 10.10.2002, p1)

Screening explanatory session
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## Background (figures)

- Estimated that humans directly consume
  - 68 % of a chicken, 62 % of a pig
  - **■** just over 50 % of a bovine, sheep or goat
- Estimated yearly EU production
  - Over 16 M tonnes of ABP of which:
    - 14 M tonnes fit for human consumption; and
    - 2 M tonnes unfit for human consumption
    - 3 M tonnes MBM; and
    - 1.5 M tonnes fat
- Crises (BSE, dioxin, FMD, CSV)



## Scope (Art 1)

- □ Collection, transport, storage, handling, processing and use or disposal of all ABP not intended for Human consumption
- □ Importation, transit, trade and export of ABP and derived products referred to in Annexes VII and VIII



### Key objectives

- Ban on recycling dead animals & condemned material (Art. 4, 5)
  - Feed: only material from animal fit for HC
  - High processing standards
  - Dedication of facilities
  - Marking
- Alternative disposal methods and uses (Art. 4, 5, 6)
  - Waste recovery
  - Safe uses as feeds, fertilisers, cosmetics, pharmaceuticals, etc
- □ Link with Environmental legislation (Art. 4, 5, 6)
  - Cross-reference to environmental legislation



#### □ Re-enforcing controls and traceability

- Traceability of ABP (Art. 7, 8)
  - Record keeping
  - Commercial document OR health certificate
  - HACCP
  - Markers
  - Official controls
    - MS (Art. 26)
    - FVO => Community inspections and audits (Art. 27)
  - Importation (Art. 29, 30, 31)
    - Listing of third countries and approved plants
    - Health certificates
    - Equivalency



#### 3 Categories

#### Category 1 material

■ ABP presenting TSE risks (SRM), unknown risks, risks from treatment with illegal substances or ENV contaminants, catering waste from international transport (Art. 4(1))

#### Category 2 material

■ ABP presenting risk related to animal diseases (fallen stock)/residues of veterinary drugs, manure (Art. 5(1))

#### Category 3 material

■ ABP from healthy animals (ante/post mortem), no risk to animal/human (Art. 6(1))




### Traceability


- □ Collection, transport, identification (Art. 7, Annex II)
  - ■C. document, H. certificate (Annex II)
- □ Dispatch of Cat. 1 & 2 and processed Cat. 3 to other MS (Art. 8)
  - Notification, authorisation (ANIMO system)
  - C. document/H. certificate
  - Conveyed directly to the approved plant of destination
- □ Records (Art. 9)
  - Any person consigning, transporting or receiving ABP (Annex II)




#### Disposal routes/uses Cat. 1 (Art. 4(2))



























#### Approval of plants

- □ Intermediate plants (Art. 10, Annex III)
- ☐ Storage plants (Art. 11, Annex III)
- ☐ (Co)-incineration plants (Art. 12, Annex IV)
- □ Processing plants for Cat. 1 & 2 (Art. 13, Annex V)
- □ Oleo-chemical plants Cat. 2 &3 (Art. 14, Annex VI)
- □ Biogas and composting plants (Art. 15, Annex VI)
- □ Processing plants Cat. 3 (Art. 17, Annex V)
- □ Petfood and technical plants (Art. 18, Annex VIII)

#### Import, transit, trade, export

- □ Import & export of Cat. 1 & 2 not allowed (Art. 4(4), 5(4))
- □ Placing on market and use of PAP and other processed products subject to compliance with the Regulation (Art. 16)
- □ Cat. 3 and products referred to in Annexes VII & VIII (Art. 19, 20, 29) allowed from
  - Third countries listed in Annex XI
  - Listed establishments (pending listing = equivalency, bilateral)
  - Health certificates (models in Annex X)
- □ Equivalency (Art. 30)





#### Restrictions on use (Art. 22)

#### Prohibition

- ■Intra-species recycling (cannibalism)
- Feeding catering waste
- Spreading organic fertiliser and soil improver on pastureland



#### Derogation on use (Art. 23)

- □ Diagnostic, educational and research purposes
- □ Taxidermy purposes
- □ Local feeding practices for Cat. 2 (zoo, circus, reptiles, birds of prey, fur, wild animals, kennels/packs of hounds the meat of which is not destined for human consumption or feeding of farmed animals) (Annex IX)
- MS to notify the Commission of the uses of the derogation and verification arrangements in place. MS to draw up list of users and collection centres



## Derogation on disposal (Art. 24)


- □ Burial of dead pet animals
- □ Burial or burning "on-site" of fallen stock (except TSE suspect or positive animals), Cat. 2 & 3 materials
  - ■Remote areas
  - Diseases outbreak
- MS to inform the Commission of derogated areas and reasons



#### Control and inspections

- □ Plants' own-checks (Art. 25)
  - Operator must put in place HACCP
- □ Official controls and list of plants (Art. 26)
  - Frequent inspections & supervisions by CA
  - List of approved plants, copy to other MS & the Commission
- □ Community controls in Member States (Art. 27)
  - FVO to carry out on-the-spot checks
  - Co-operation with national CA
