  - ✓ Implementation Regulation on Fisheries,
  - ✓ Implementing Regulation on Wholesale and Retail Fish Markets,
  - ✓ Circular for Regulating Commercial Fishing,
- Law no. 5200 on Agricultural Producer Unions(2004);
  - ✓ Implementing Regulation on the Establishment Procedures and Principles of Agricultural Producer Associations
  - ✓ Implementing Regulation on Inspections of Agricultural Producer Unions and Central Union of Agricultural Producers,
- > Law no. 1163 on Cooperatives (1969);
  - √ Main Status of Fisheries Cooperative





#### II. MARKETING STANDARDS





> Freshness criteria are set in the "Implementing Regulation on Fisheries"

These criteria;

- ✓ Compatible, to a great extent, with EC Regulation no. 2406/96;
- ✓ used to control the eligibility of products for human consumption.





> Size categories do not exist in national legislation,

For stock conservation purposes, Minimum landing size and weight standards are laid down in the "Circular no. 36/1 Regulating Commercial Fishing in Seas and Inland Waters"





#### III. CONSUMER INFORMATION





Implementing Regulation on Fisheries;

imposes an obligation on labelling of packaged fishery products to be placed on the market





# According to the Implementing Regulation on Wholesale and Retail Fish Markets;

- ➤ A document is issued when products enter and leave the wholesale market.
  - ✓ The information on this document corresponds to labeling information referred to in EU Regulation no.2065/2001.





# According to the Implementing Regulation on Wholesale and Retail Fish Markets;

- ➤ In retail markets it is obligatory to put a label on products,
  - ✓ Name and price of the product





#### Inspections are carried out by

- MARA Inspectors and
- > Authorized staff of municipalities

#### **Producer Organizations do exist;**

But their legal status and organization types partly comply with the provisions of the EU legislation.





#### Law no. 5200 on Agricultural Producers Union (APU)

- ✓ Implementing Regulation on the Establishment Procedures and Principles of APUs
- ✓ Implementing Regulation on Inspections of APUs and Central Union of Agricultural Producers
- > Law no. 1163 on Cooperatives
  - ✓ Fisheries Cooperative Main Status





#### Law no. 5200 on Agricultural Producer Unions

#### **Producer Union should have;**

- > minimum 16 producers
- minimum production capacity based on product and product group

#### In fishing

✓ Marine products : 1,600 t/year

✓Inland fisheries : 400 t/year

#### In aquaculture

✓ Marine products : 300 t/year

✓Inland fisheries : 80 t/year





#### Law no. 1163 on Cooperatives

Fisheries Cooperative is established with a main status signed by at least 7 partners of the cooperative.

#### **A-National Legislation**

- ✓ Law on Customs Tariff Code (No: 474)
- ✓ Law on Regulating Foreign Trade (No: 2976)
- ✓ Import Regime Decree (No: 95/7606)
- ✓ Export Regime Decree (No:95/7623)





#### **B-International Arrangements**

- ✓ EU-TURKEY Association Council Decision 1/98
- √ Free Trade Agreements





#### **EU-Turkey Trade on Fisheries**

#### **EU-Turkey Association Council Decision 1/98**

✓ Importation into the Community of fishery products originating in Turkey is exempted from Ad Valorem duties (Protocol I Article 2.1)

#### **Turkish Import Regime Decree 95/7606**

Two types of customs duties applicable for importation into Turkey of fishery pruducts;

- ✓ Ad Valorem Duty
- ✓ Mass Housing Fund





#### Free Trade Agreements-I

Free trade agreements consisting of mutual concessions for certain fisheries;

- ✓ EFTA
- ✓ Bulgaria
- √ Croatia
- ✓ Tunisia
- ✓ Bosnia and Herzegovina





#### Free Trade Agreements-II

- Within the framework of these agreements;
  - ✓ Tariff preferences reflected to Turkish Import Regime Decree (No: 95/7606)
  - ✓ Concessional tariff quotas are allocated each year
  - ✓ Import licences required under tariff quotas resulting from bilateral agreements

# For alignment with EC Regulation no. 104/2000, 2406/96 and 2065/2001;

- ➤ Preliminary Draft Amending the Fisheries Law has been drawn up
- >Technical studies on CMO are underway
