Responsible Authorities

- > DGLT is responsible for
 - setting rules on transport of dangerous goods by rail
 - supervision
- > TCDD is responsible for
 - carriage of dangerous goods





Legislation

Transport of dangerous goods by rail

For domestic:

- ➤ Internal Operational Instruction on Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Rail, issued by TCDD, No 505 dated 28.04.2005.
- ➤ Technical studies on "By-Law on Transport of Dangerous Goods by Rail" is underway.
- ➤ Informal translation of RID Regulations.

For international:

Complies with the provisions of RID.





Current Status (CONT'D)

- > TCDD has:
 - specialised staff only for carriage of dangerous goods.
 - no specialised staff for regulatory and supervisory activities relating to the transport of dangerous goods by rail,
- ➤ Affiliated companies, TUDEMSAS and TULOMSAS manufacture wagons for transport of dangerous goods in compliance with RIV.





Ongoing Studies and Future Plans

Technical studies are going on pertaining to the transport of dangerous goods by rail;

- Well definition of responsibilities within TCDD
- Clear definition of monitoring, inspection and authorisation functions in the rail sector
- Competences and responsibilities of each organisation according to "General Railway Framework Law" and the secondary legislation
- Regulation of matters by a unit under MoT
