# Energy Labelling – Enforcement Information Availability

- **Label** – In shops
- **‘Fiche’** - available
- **Distance Selling** – on internet  
mail order catalogues etc.



# Energy Labelling – Implementing Directive Information

- **Self Declaration by Manufacturers**
- **‘Harmonized Standards’**  
– but compulsory
