


#### **Overview**

- TURKSTAT has compiled statistics on fish production since 1967





















- 1. Characteristics of Vessels Used in Fishery

- 4. Credits Taken by Fisherman Only for Fishing
- 5. Expenditure for Fishery Activities
- 6. Fixed Capital Investment and Sales for Fishing Activities
- 7. Quantity & Value of Fish Caught During the Year
- 8. Quantity & Value of Crustaceas, Molluscs During the Year
- 9. Distribution of Production
- 10. Type of Marketing and Selling
- 11. Income & Expenditure

#### **Variables**

#### **Freshwater**

quantity and value of fish caught

#### **Aquaculture**

Location and capacity of farm

Cultured species, amount of production, sale price





### **Future plans**

Implementation of a computerised fishery vessel registration and statistical information system

There is a Twinning Project on Fisheries Policy under the responsibility of MARA, scheduled to end by March 2007. At the end of this project, landing places at 30 largest ports will be established, which will allow flow of data to TURKSTAT
