Overview

- Data compilation on social protection started in January 2004 for the period of 2000-2003
- Available data sent to EUROSTAT in August 2004

Methodology

Coverage: These 30 institutions are covered (data are not available from municipalities, associations and foundations)

Classification: ESSPROS Methodology Manual

Data Source: Administrative registers

Periodicity: Annual

Reference period: Previous financial year



Methodology (cont'd)

Dissemination

- 2004 qualitative data was sent to EUROSTAT in March 2006
- 2005 updated qualitative information will be sent to EUROSTAT before June 2007
- 2004-2005 quantitative and 2003-2004 pension beneficiary data will be sent to EUROSTAT before June 2007



Future Plans

- Studies on the extension of the coverage of organization are underway
- Survey with associations and foundations will be conducted in 2008
- Methodological studies on the alternative data sources (i.e., analytical budget) will begin in 2007
