- The survey of “ICT Usage in Enterprises” was conducted in 2005

Eurostat's "Model Questionnaire for ICT Usage in Households" is used as recommended by "New Methodological Manual for Statistics on the Information Society"

ICT Usage in Households (cont'd)

Coverage: All households at national level by urban and rural breakdown

Data Source: Face to face survey at sampled households

Periodicity: Annual

- The data of 2004 was sent to Eurostat

ICT Usage in Enterprises (cont'd)

Coverage: Enterprises having following activities of NACE Rev 1.1

Section D	Manufacturing
Section F	Construction
Section G	Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles, motorcycles and personal and household goods
Group 55.1	Hotels
Group 55.2	Camping sites and other provision of short stay accommodation
Section I	Transport, storage and communication
Section K	Real estate, renting and business activities
Group 92.1	Motion picture and video activities
Group 92.2	Motion picture and video activities” and “Radio and television activities

ICT Usage in Enterprises (cont'd)

Data Source

Sample survey with enterprises, having 10 or more persons employed

Periodicity: Annual

Dissemination

- Press release on paper and electronic media on TURKSTAT web site, annual
- The data of 2005 will be sent to Eurostat by the end of 2006



Future Plans

Each of the two ICT usage surveys will be carried out multi-annually in the short-term, and annually in the medium-term
