## Overview

TURKSTAT has implemented following studies for structural indicators

### Until the end of 2001

- A coordinator was nominated by TURKSTAT to steer all activities for the co-ordination of structural indicators (SI) within TURKSTAT and within Turkish Statistical System
- Provision of a comprehensive list of contact persons within TURKSTAT for each indicator domain (General Economic Background, Employment, Innovation and Research, Economic Reform, Social Cohesion and Environment)



## Overview (cont'd)

### In 2002

The questionnaire was filled out in collaboration with other data providers and sent to EUROSTAT

### 2003 - 2004

TURKSTAT involved in the technical meetings on structural indicators of Statistical Programme Committee (SPC)
