












Council Regulation (EC) N° 2007/2004 of 26 October 2004 (Establishing FRONTEX)

Main tasks (I):

- Coordinate operational cooperation
- Assist Member States on training of national border guards, including the establishment of common training standards
- Carry out risk analyses

FRONTEX (Main tasks (II))

- Follow up on the development of research relevant for the control and surveillance of external borders
- Assist Member States in circumstances requiring increased technical and operational assistance at the external borders
- Provide Member States with the necessary support in organising joint return operations

Objectives of FRONTEX

 Facilitate and render more effective the application of existing and future Community measures relating to the management of external borders













FRONTEX in an international context
