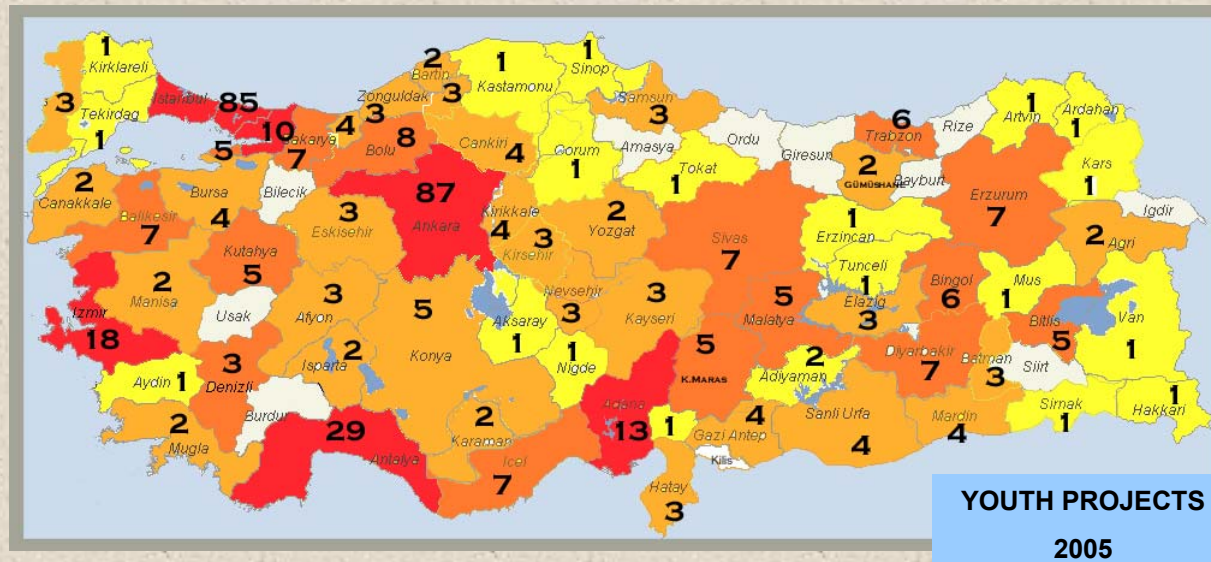
“Wireless Lan Area Between Computers ”

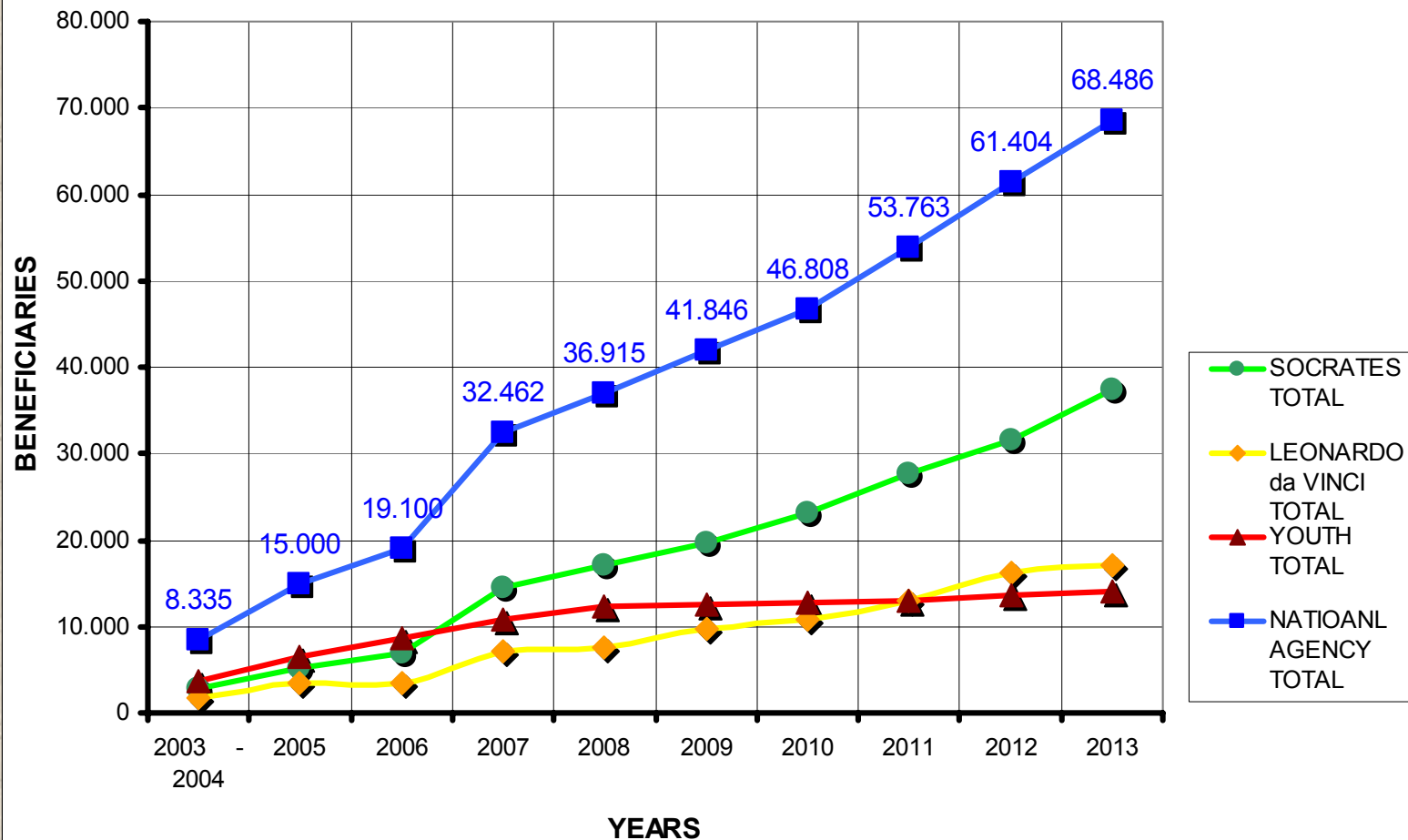
