4.1 CHILDREN OF MIGRANT WORKERS

- ✓ **Implementing Regulation regarding the Education of Immigrant Workers' Children has been prepared by MoNE (2002)**
- ✓ **Responsibilities of MoNE:**
 - **Settlement of foreign students**
 - **Conducting guidance services**
- ✓ **Education available in private education institutions**
 - **Article 28 of Law on Private Education Institutions (Law no.625)**

4.2 NON-DISCRIMINATION

- ✓ **Government Decree No 2004/6905 (2004) ensuring the “reciprocity principle”**
 - **already applying this principle through bilateral agreements based on the Government Decree No 2002/4727 (Article 9)**
- ✓ **Ready to apply the requirements with full membership**
- ✓ **Education available in private education institutions**
 - **Article 28 of Law on Private Education Institutions (Law no.625)**
 - **280 teachers and 2517 students in private education institutions**

4.3 ADMISSION OF THIRD COUNTRY NATIONALS

- ✓ **Admission of third country nationals and financial assistance based on Law no. 2922 and its related regulation and specifications**

4.3 ADMISSION OF THIRD COUNTRY NATIONALS

- ✓ **3 main dimensions in terms of admission conditions of foreign students**
 - **Students with their own financial resources through**
 - **An examination assessing the basic learning skills
(Entrance Examination for Foreign Students)**
 - **Students through cultural agreements and cultural exchange programmes**
 - **Selection by a joint committee of representatives of each country**
 - **One-year education of Turkish language**
 - **Students from Central Asian Republics**
 - **A central examination and placement by CoHE**
