# Background (2)

- Two aspects to enforce consumer rights
  - Protection of the individual interest of consumer
  - Protection of the collective interests of consumers





#### Objectives of the Directive

Directive establishes a procedure to stop unlawful practice that harm the collective interest of consumer

The Directive is not intended as a means of seeking redress for individual consumers.





#### Main elements (1)

- Member States must designate the courts or administrative authorities competent to rule on injunctive order
- Scope: any practice contrary to the national provisions implementing 12 EU consumer Directives and which harm the collective interests of consumers





### Main elements (2)

- Qualified entities: body or organisation which have a legitimate interest to protect the collective interest of consumers
- Qualified entities on the list published by the European Commission in the OJCE can seek an injunction in a Member State other than the one where the affected consumers are located.





# Main elements (3)

- Summary procedure must be available
- Publication of the decision or publication of corrective statement must be available
- Non compliance order: if possible under national legislation
- Prior consultation: an option





#### **Exclusions**

The directive is without prejudice to the rules on applicable law

Member States can adopt measures that goes beyond the scope of the directive
