How is the EU addressing today's challenges of insecurity and violent conflict?

- Historical perspective: dealing with inter-state conflict in Europe through economic integration rather than through traditional security policy means
- End of Cold War, the Balkan and Rwanda experiences in early 90s





- Comprehensive approach to crisis management, and Conflict prevention
 - CFSP and community instruments
 - Prevention better than cure structural stability by addressing root causes of conflict
 - Conflict prevention using the full potential of the EU instruments

- Mainstreaming through policy development, training and information sharing

- Promoting international co-operation with EU partners (OECD, OSCE, UN, civil society, regional organisations)

- OECD-DAC (MS, EC) work on CP and on crosscutting issues
